God grants prayers requesting [extension of] life for believers not sinning a sin that

leads to death (5:16a)

God does not grant [extension of] life in response to prayers for [extension of] life for believers sinning a sin that leads to death (5:16b)
John does not urge inquiring whether one's sin is a sin unto death [but urges that we pray for individuals—even those who may be guilty of such a sin (5:16c) The word mistranslated pray by the NKJ is erōtaō (to ask). Explanation:
A misunderstanding of this verse is central to Catholic teaching on mortal sins.
All sin is unrighteousness, but not all sin is unto death (5:17)
The one who is born of God does not sin [specifically, the regenerate seed does not sin] and is protected against satanic attack; but the world is under the control of the wicked one (5:18-19) Cf. 1 John 3:9-10
The Incarnated Son of God has given the apostles understanding; so they know Him (in Jesus Christ, His Son) who is true (5:20a)
This is the [experience of] God and [the experience] of everlasting life (5:20b)
The readers are to guard themselves from idols (5:21)
