Predicting Judas' Betrayal (13:21-30)

13₂₁ Upon saying these *things*, Jesus was troubled in spirit and testified, saying, "Amen, amen, I tell you•, one of you• will betray Me."

13₂₂ So the disciples, uncertain about whom He was speaking, were glancing at each other.

13₂₃ Now one of His disciples (the one whom Jesus loved) was reclining by the chest of Jesus.

13₂₄ So Simon Peter motioned to him to inquire who it might be— about whom He was speaking.

13₂₅ And thus leaning back toward Jesus' chest, he said to Him, "Lord, who is he?"

13₂₆ Jesus answered, "He is the one to whom I will give a piece *of bread* after dipping." And upon dipping a piece *of bread*, He gave it to Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*.

13₂₇ So after the piece *of bread*, Satan entered him. So Jesus told him, "What you do, do quickly."

13₂₈ But none of those reclining knew why He told him this.

13₂₉ For some supposed, since Judas held the *common* purse, that Jesus was telling him, "Buy the things we need for the feast," or that he should give something to the poor.

13₃₀ So having received the piece *of bread*, he immediately went out. Now it was night.

The New Commandment (13:31-35)

13₃₁ When he left, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him.

13₃₂ "If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will at once glorify Him.

13₃₃ “Little children, I am with you• a little while. You• will seek Me, and as I told Judeans, ‘Where I am going you• cannot come,’ so now I tell you•.

13₃₄ “I give you• a new commandment, that you• would love one another, as I have loved you•, that you• also would love one another.

13₃₅ “By this (if you• have love among yourselves•) all will know that you• are My disciples.”

Predicting Peter’s Denial

13₃₆ Simon Peter said to Him, “Lord, where are You going?” Jesus answered him, “Where I am going you cannot follow Me now; but later you will follow Me.”

13₃₇ Peter said to Him, “Lord, why can I not follow You now? I will lay down my *mortal* life for You.”

13₃₈ Jesus answered him, “Will you lay down your *mortal* life for Me? Amen, amen, I tell you, a rooster will not crow until you have denied Me three times.”

The Way, the Truth, and the Life (14:1-6)

14₁ “Let not your• heart be troubled. Believe• in God, believe• also in Me.

14₂ “In My Father’s house are many abodes. Now, if it were not so, I would have told you•. I go to prepare a place for you•.

14₃ “And if I go and prepare a place for you•, I am coming again and will receive you• to Myself, so where I am you• also may be.

14₄ “And you• know where I am going and you• know the way.”

14₅ Thomas said to Him, “Lord, we do not know where You are going, so how can we know the way?”

14₆ Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”
